The service is for leaseholders and freeholders who bought their properties from Southwark Council, through Right to Buy or from a previous owner.

We provide independent advice on general and specialised leasehold / freehold matters including:

- Challenging annual service charges and major works payment demands; e.g., if you think the council is spending and charging too much on services or major works.
- Rights to be consulted and provided with information.
- Challenging the standard of services or building works that you think are not value for money.
- Neglect of the building or estate which is affecting your property.
- Understanding rights and responsibilities under the lease / freehold transfer.
- The Council's repair obligations.
- Applications to the First-Tier Tribunal (formerly known as LVT).
